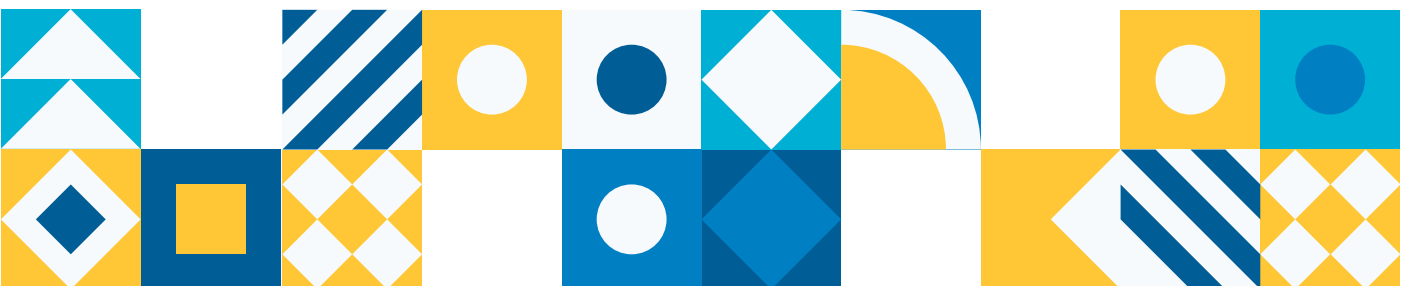
UPDATE ON MALAYSIAN PRIMARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION IS CURRENTLY AND WHAT'S FOR THE FUTURE

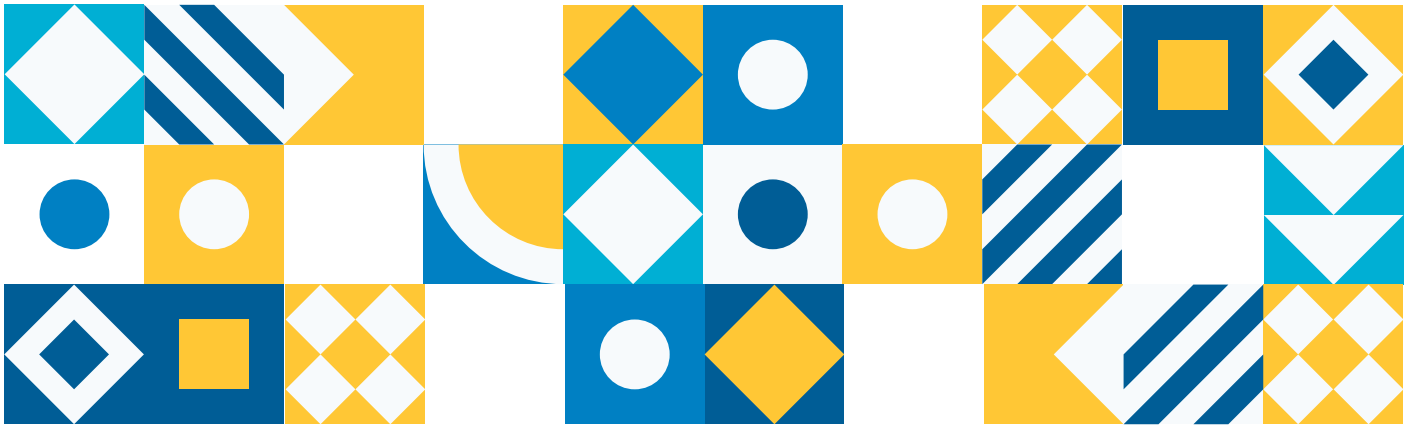
The Malaysian educational curriculum covers a total period of six years for primary education, and a further five years for secondary.

At its core, the aim of the curriculum is to provide a good foundation for students to be more proficient in reading, writing and arithmetic from as early stage as possible, and adding on with the major learning subjects to help nurture their minds into a well-rounded thinker.

These objectives are the main thinking points when the syllabus used during the educational phase, or cohorts, are reviewed and tweaked in line with developments locally, regionally, and globally, which provides the baseline in standards applied.

References and comparisons with the syllabus applied elsewhere are important to ensure the country's education is at par with other countries especially our regional neighbours including Singapore and China.





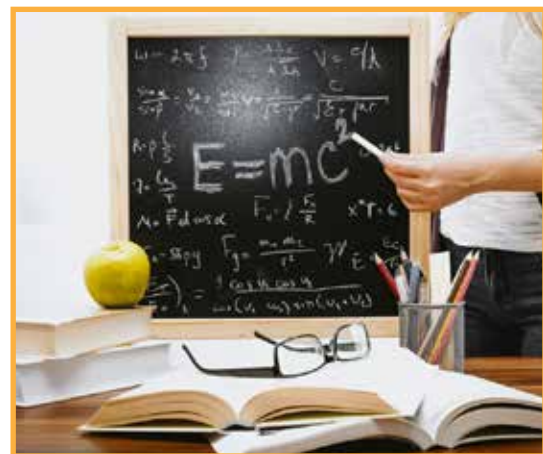
Syllabus deals with the framework and methodology for implementation which is tasked to schools and the teaching staff, the professionals who needed the prerequisite skillsets and competencies to undertake such lofty responsibilities.

This year marked the start of a new cohort, the last one having started in 2017 and ending in 2022.

Under normal circumstances, students are expected to go through the planned phases of teaching as laid out in the syllabus, step by step to allow adequate grasps and understanding of each of the taught subject.

One of the most surprising, and to the students entering primary schools, was the decision to do away with examinations for Standards 1 to 3 in 2019, with the progressive, School-Based Assessment method introduced as its replacement.

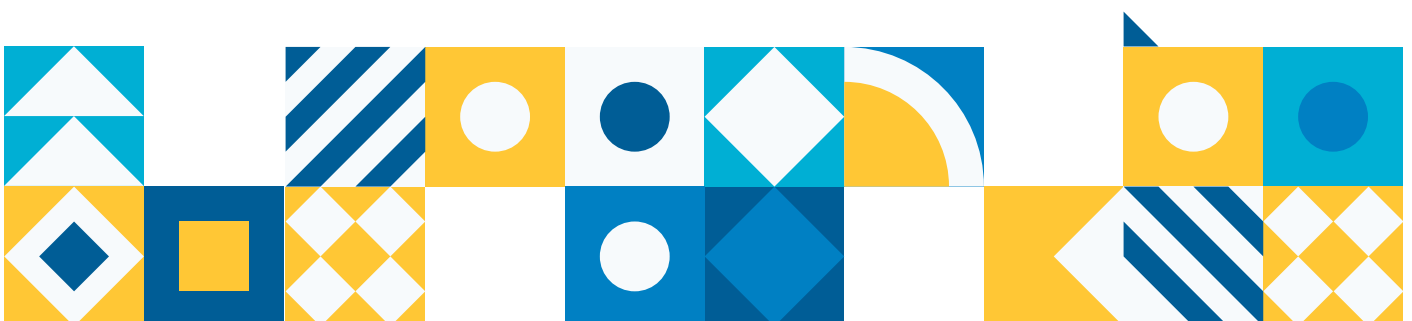
This revolutionary move was followed through with a full strengthening of the new assessment method with the abolishment of the Ujian Penilaian Sekolah Rendah (UPSR) for primary schools and the Form Three Assessment (PT3) for secondary schools in 2021, doing away with the exam-oriented

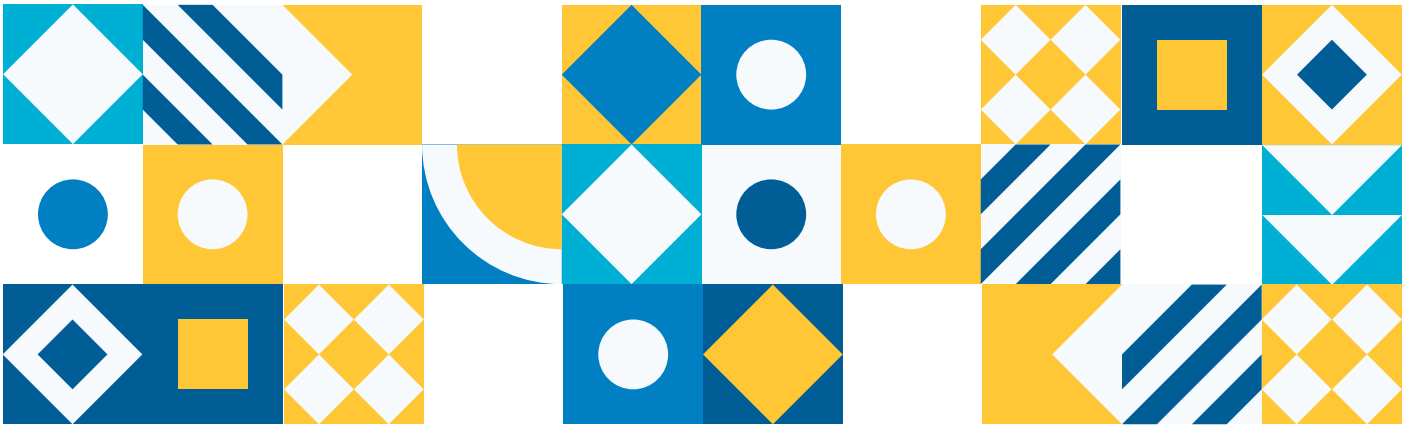


culture which had been a core trait of the schooling system for decades.

No longer were students able to get away with just excelling during the exams with assessment decentralised to a much broader range of criteria including on co-curricular participations as well as overall academic progress.

To address the introduced “burden” of individualised assessment to the teaching staff, the Ministry of Education undertook regular reviews of the descriptors used to evaluate a student’s performance to ensure greater clarity at the same time of bringing a level of comprehensiveness in the final report on a student’s level of performance.





The school closures necessitated by the Covid 19 pandemic in a way facilitated the swift adoption on the new assessment method, given the much higher levels of digitalisation input required from both teacher and students alike.

Performance data and results are channelled into a centralised database allowing access to multiple layers of users and administrators including State Education Office and District Education Department.

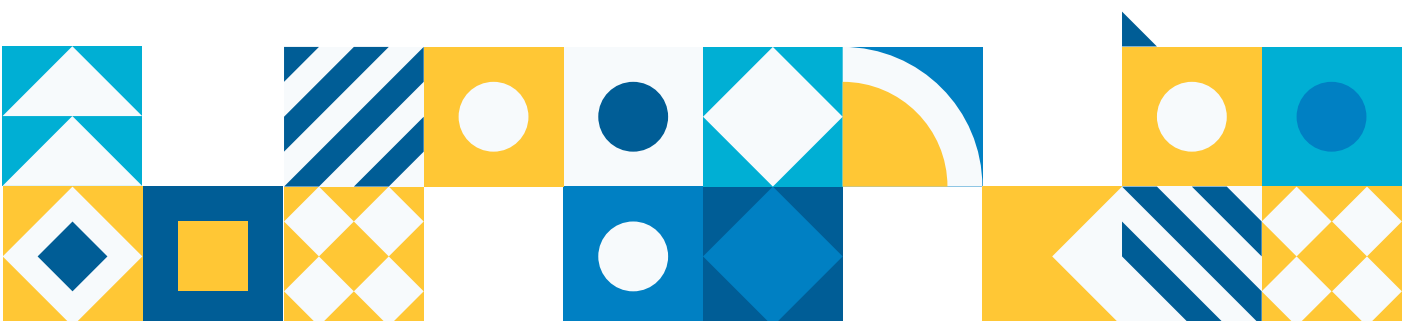
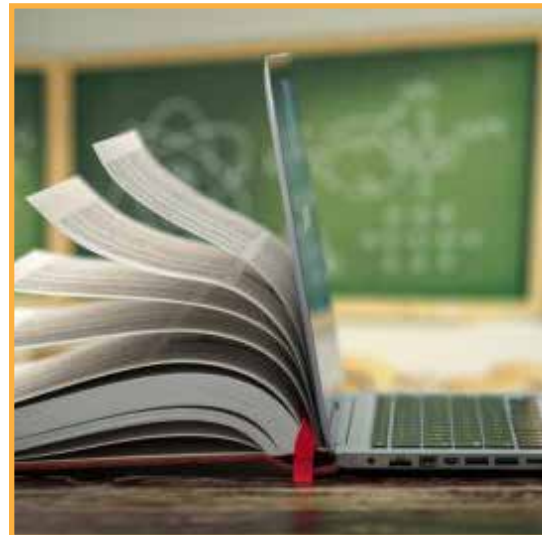
This allows a greater level of transparency to gauge the literacy and numeracy levels for the appropriate and targeted interventions could be planned where necessary for schools, state and even at national levels.

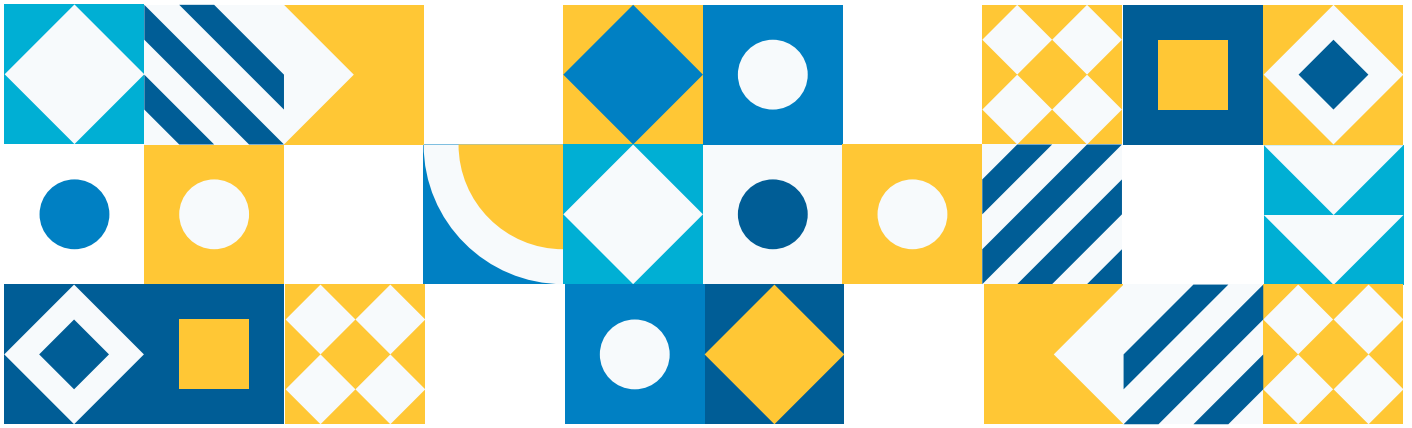
Are examinations fully done with as a result, then?

Not fully with the Ministry designating the School-Based Assessment into two categories, formative and summative.

The formative section addresses the progressive and year-long assessments of the students by teachers to determine their performance early on so that interventions can be carried out if necessary.

Summative assessments, meanwhile, are undertaken at the end of the schooling period to measure students' performance and their proficiency level at the end of every





academic session, applied to Year Four, Five and Six pupils as well as Form One, Two and Three students.

To facilitate the effective, and encompassing levels of standard across all schools, the Ministry had set up a question bank with schools given the flexibility in the timing of implementing the assessment within a specified period provided.

This also effectively do away with the competitive nature inherent in centralised examinations since comparisons of performance results for schools within districts and states is no longer an important feature and students applying to specialised, boarding schools for the secondary phase undergoing a separate special entry exam (PKSK).

As such, this effectively leaves only the Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM) as the sole major examinations for the Students to sit throughout their 11-years of studying, a gauge for their transitioning to the tertiary levels of their educational journey.

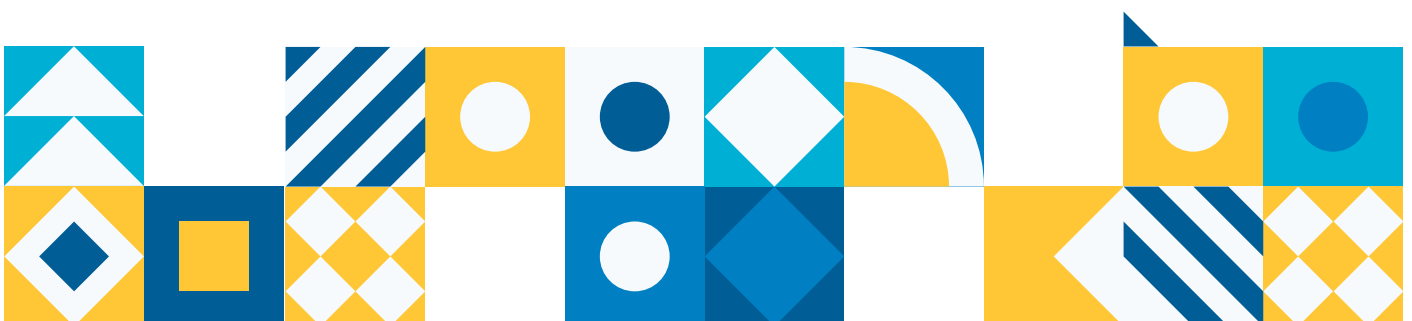
The greater levels in opportunities for students to pursue their interest, including those keen on attaining practical skills under



the technical and vocational education and training (TVET) route, could mean that even this last bastion of centralised examination saying goodbye.

The secondary education phase is critically where students will start to explore and discover what they want to do, and the path they wish to pursue in building a career.

Now, though, SPM remains, a reminder of how things had been for the older generations of school goers.





DIGITALISATION – THE ANSWER TO HEAVY BAGS AND A STAGNANT SYLLABUS? UPDATE ON CURRENT STAGE IN IMPLEMENTATION AND FUTURE PLANNING

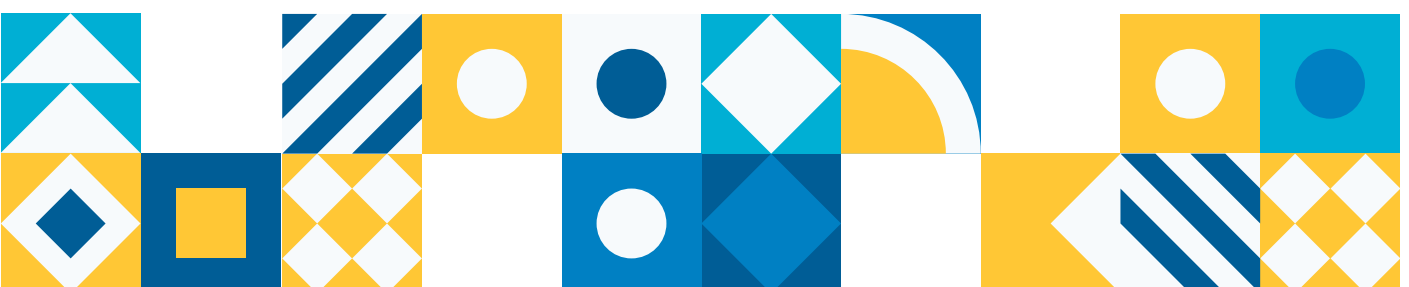
Despite the obvious solution, school going children are still forced to lug that heavy bag, laden with textbooks, activity books, and exercise books on daily basis.

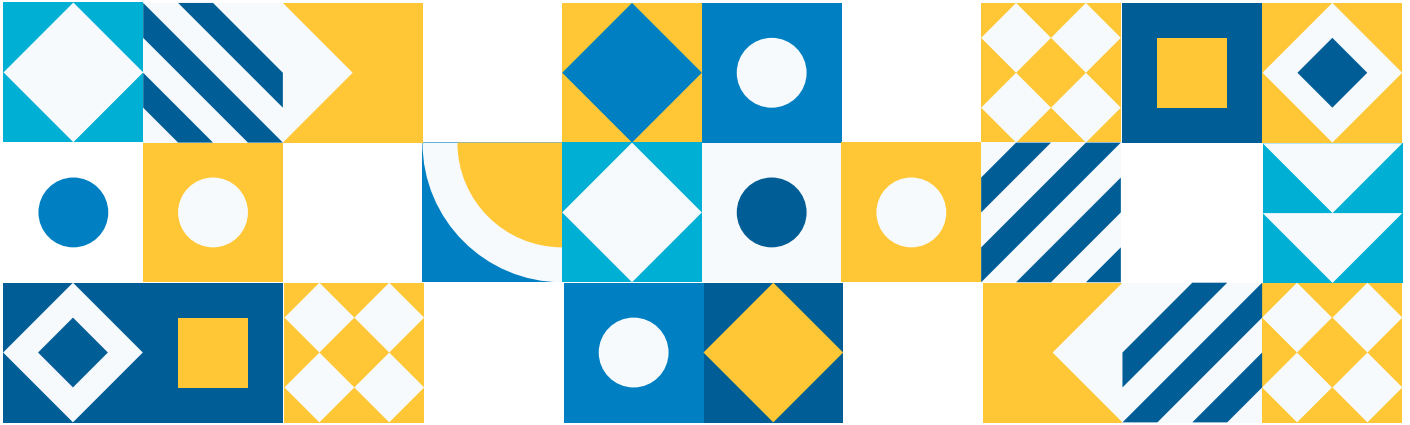
A planned push towards eBooks and usage of the Google Classroom application mooted during Budget 2020 remained that, muted.

Let us explore what have gone digital for the Malaysian education system thus far, one

aspect of modernising the whole framework which ironically the Covid 19 pandemic had forced upon us, leading to committed teachers going online to teach students still hungry for classes.

With the exam-based method for assessment done with throughout the whole six years of primary school, it is the best time to adopt at the very least a hybrid system combining both the traditional and digital methodologies.





Thus far, the Government had developed three online systems to assist in school management and facilitate teachers' work, specifically for school timetable preparation, utility management and the teachers' teaching and learning (PdP) reporting system.

All three are aimed at improving the management systems and introduce greater efficiency.

Why start with the administrative rather than the syllabus, though?

The answer is the need to speed up the digital fluency in schools especially amongst the teachers who would be in turn become capable of producing more interesting educational pedagogical approaches.

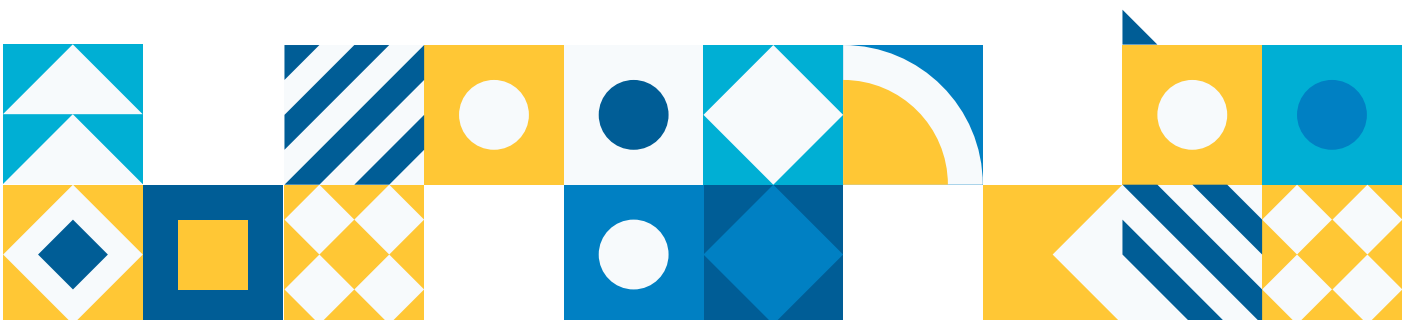
It must be noted that while the syllabus dictates what is taught, the actual method of teaching, and more importantly, the communication of the methodologies is in the hands of teachers who would need to face the children, be it face to face or online.

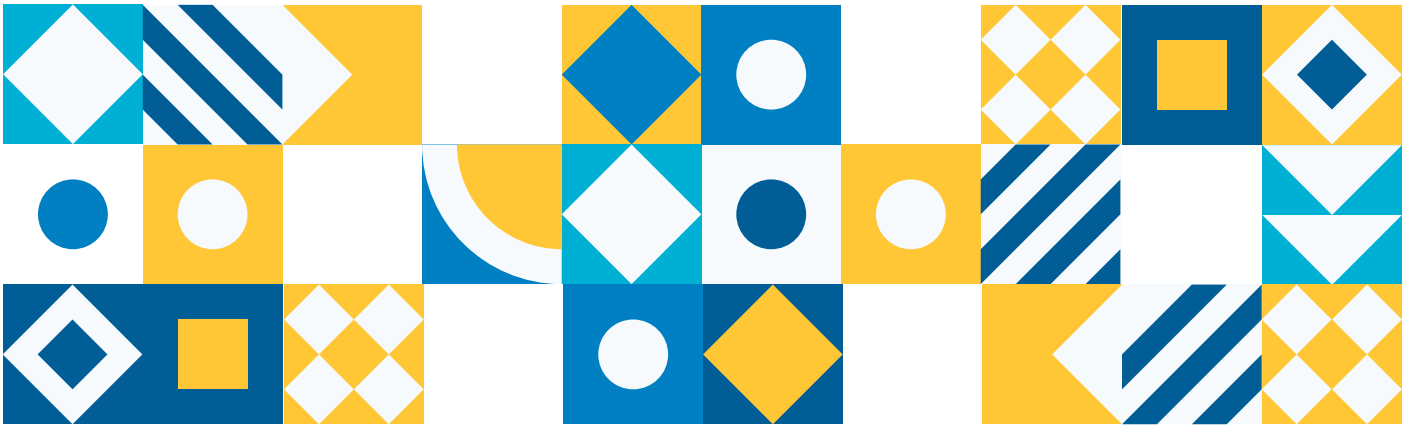
Digitalisation is not just e-books, but utilising them on an effective manner, and we have seen a glimpse of how it could work during the Covid-19 enforced online classrooms, with online quizzes, digital submissions, video presentations and the likes.

In other words, the intense dynamism in technological progress and the voracious adaptability of children would need to be matched by teachers to ensure the successful implementation of greater digitalisation of the Malaysian education system.

A fair number of digitalisations initiatives to date are on the data management side allowing schools, and parents, to review and update the profiles for school children as well as their academic assessments for a real time access to important information.

It is the next step of the process that is proving more difficult given the understanding in how online learning could never fully





displace traditional textbooks for obvious reasons including access, ease of use and, most importantly, level of competencies on both teachers and students.

As at date, the country has the infrastructural support in place for any eventual transition.

Digital platforms such as Delima established through a strategic partnership with UNICEF providing online learning to help students keep up with their classes.

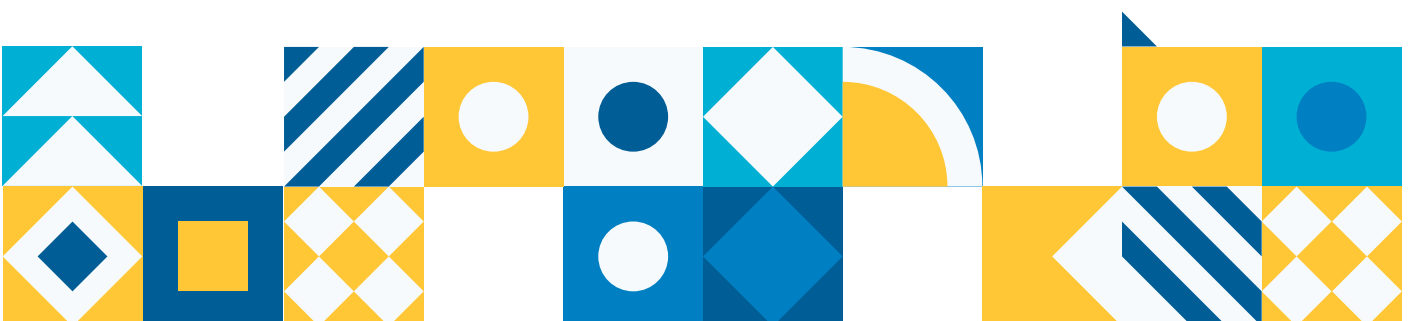
Delima proved there is life for a hybrid teaching system blending face-to-face and online learning with over four million children and young people logging on during

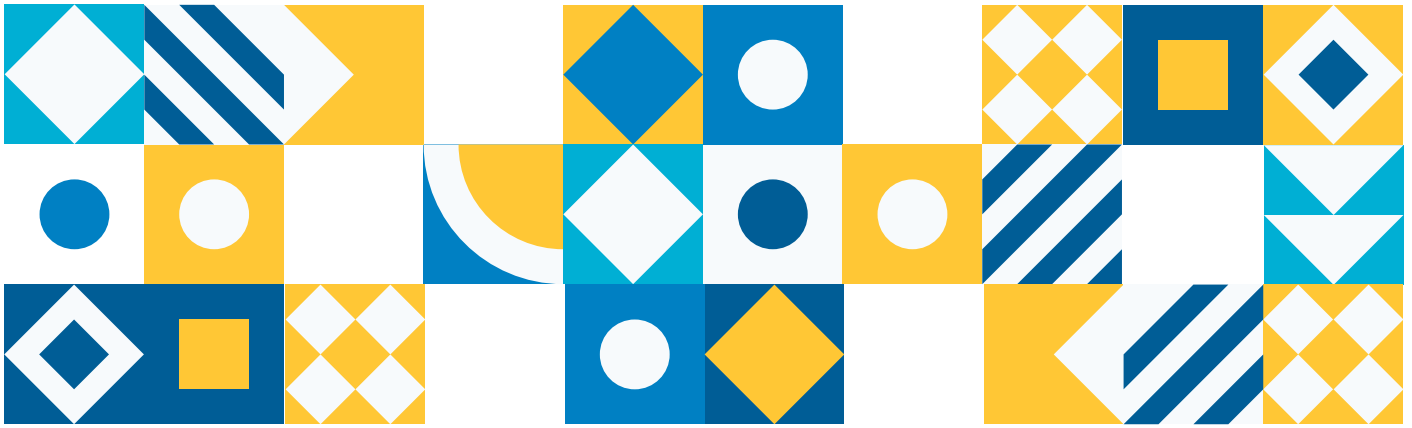


the Covid 19 lockdown, including the more rural areas, with much help from enterprising teachers providing much needed access to facilities and apparatus.

A second programme under the same initiative is the Global Citizenship Education (GCED) and aligned to the national curriculum aimed at building participants' tech skill at the same time of imbuing them with a global-centric a growth mindset.

A form of civic learning, GCED empower learners to engage and assume active civic roles, participating in global challenges in four areas: mathematics, science, history, and geography, and play a proactive contributors' role towards making the world a more inclusive, secure and sustainable place to live.





Yes. Like the world-building, strategy games which are the rave these days with youths. The GCED module has reached over 80,000 users with the project-based lessons, which allow access to both teachers and students for a highly interactive learning experience.

Amongst the surprise discovery from this hybrid system adventure was how it allowed the more introverted students to express themselves in class which was more difficult in the physical setting and how it allowed the teaching of some lessons to be far more dynamic given the greater availability of digital and virtual resources.

These resources are however both a boon as well as a bane for especially students as, unlike teachers, they are not privy the overall framework for each subject and hence the need for teachers to still be at hand to guide the acquisition of knowledge.

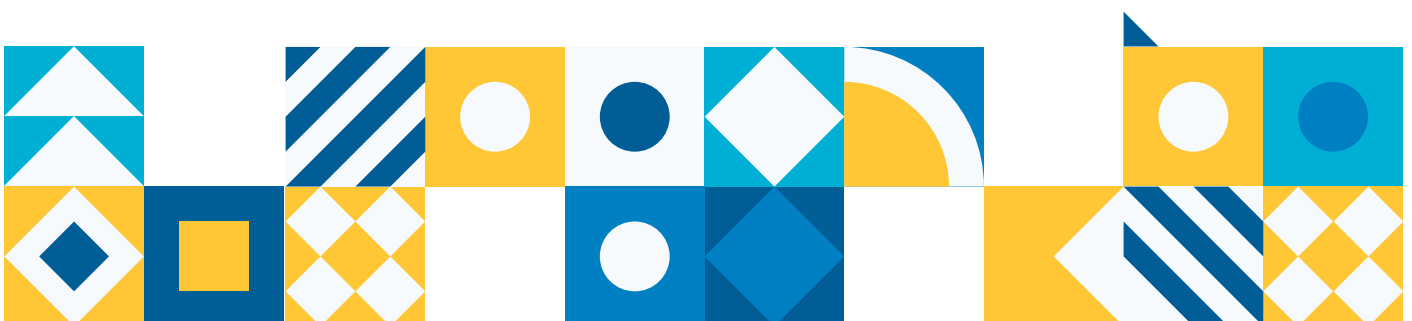
Digital technology is nonetheless best in providing the immersive, and sometimes almost virtual experience with the application of gaming activities and assignments which not only help imparts knowledge on the subjects but also in increasing one's (student and teacher alike) competency in information technology.

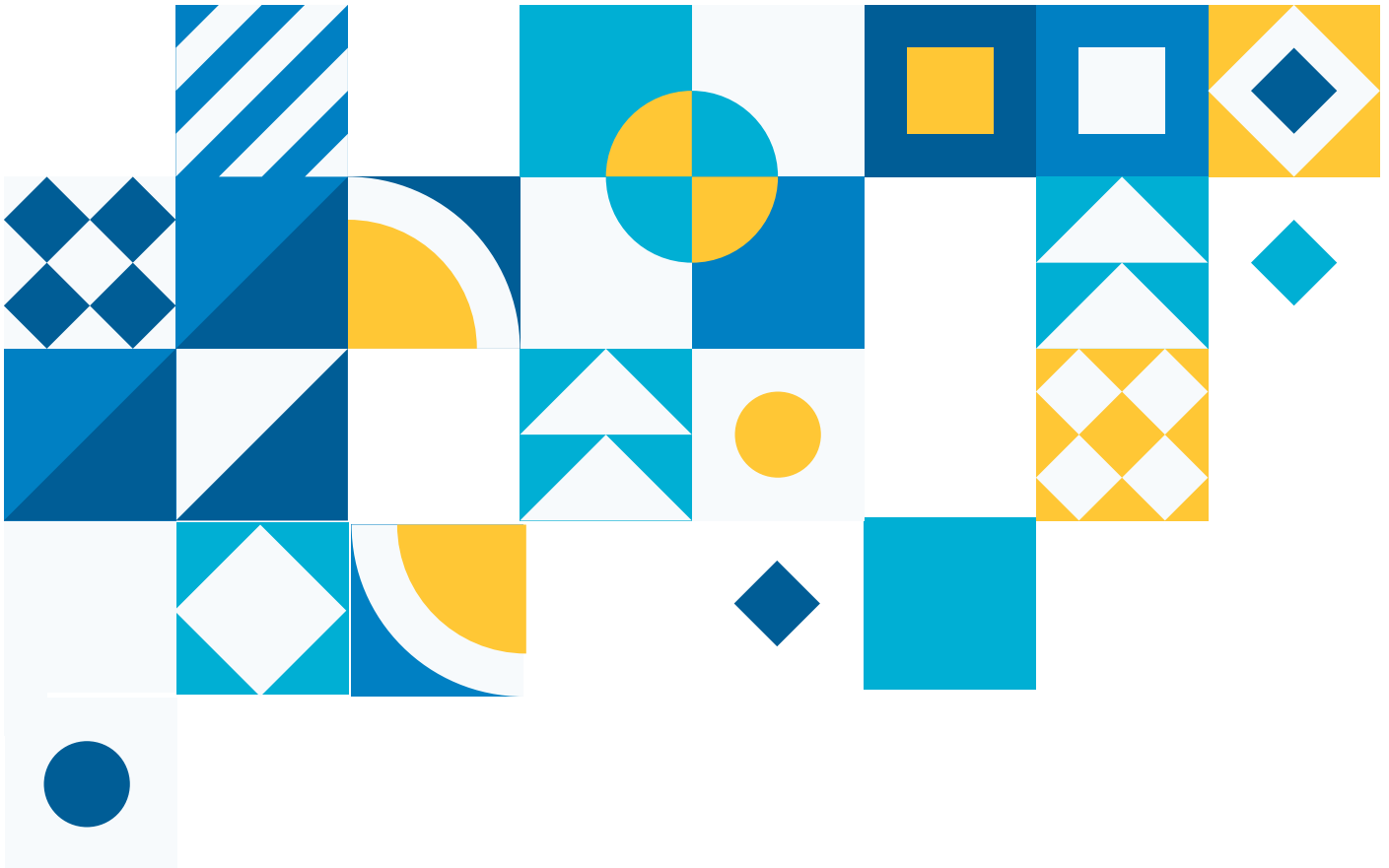


Ask any child, as there will always be a fascination on technology, especially when they are given the chance to use them and gain benefit at the same time.

There is a stronger impetus to push ahead with much greater digitalisation of the education syllabus and with the country's Internet penetration rate stands at 89.6 per cent, one of the highest in Southeast Asia, access can no longer be a credible barrier toward implementation.

And, finally our school children will no longer be burden with lugging bags as though packed for a weekend travel.





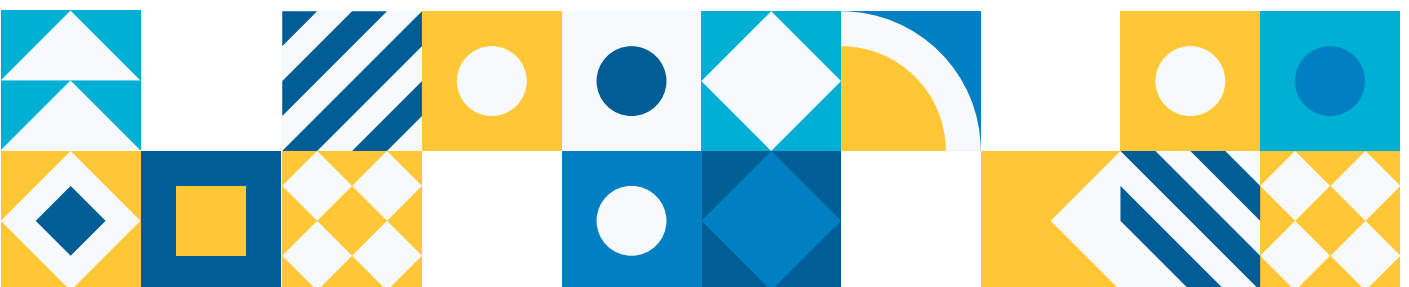
THE PROS AND CONS OF A MUCH TOUGHER SYLLABUS, AND WHY WE SHOULD PUSH ON.

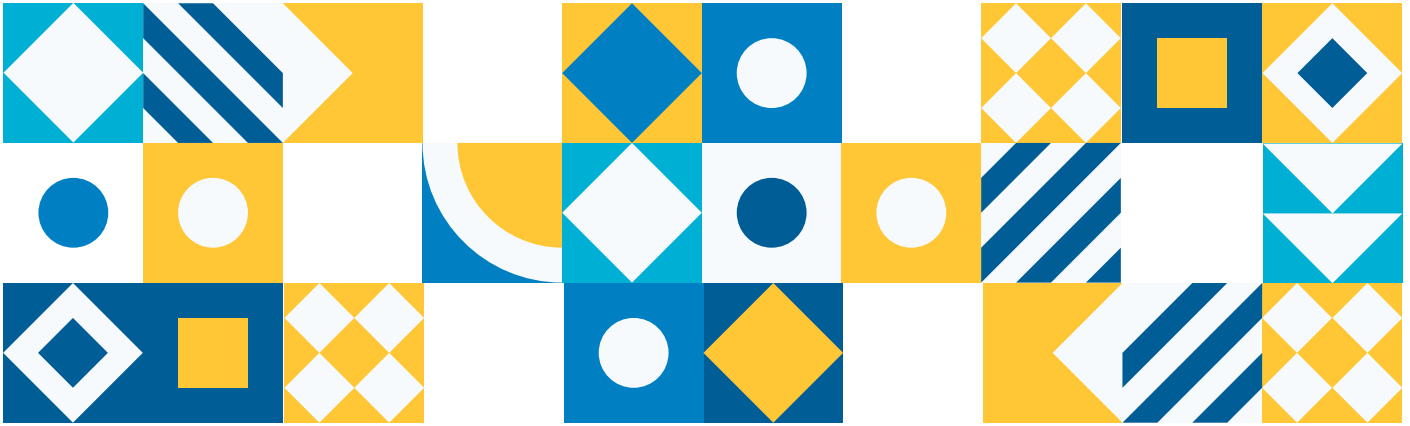
There was an almost inaudible hurrah when the Government had relaxed restrictions on the opening of schools after months of closure starting March 2020 following the Covid 19 pandemic.

However, normalcy did not return until October last year with the nation having successfully implementing a widespread vaccination programme covering all strata of the society including school-going children.

The restrictions imposed had given rise to greater use of online teaching to enable a continuation of studies, however Malaysia found itself missing a substantial block of teaching hours as well as stragglers amongst those without access to such facilities or even opportunities.

Parents too found themselves being exposed to the syllabus, and from this came rumblings in how tougher it is for their children.





The issue came to the fore again courtesy of a viral social media posting made by a teacher who opined that the Standard One Mathematics syllabus are “too advanced” and thus unsuitable for the students.

As we adapt the 6/5 years cohort system for primary and secondary schooling periods, similarly a review is undertaken for the national educational syllabus every six years as well. Other than the current and previous cohorts’ syllabus, those tasked with such responsibility will make references to the syllabus used in other countries as well as to ensure we are neither too far forward, nor are we too far behind.

Factors considered includes fairness of grasping the methodologies used so that there

is an appreciably measurable benchmark in the students’ ability to understand and absorb what was taught.

The prolonged closure meant however that the planned-out stages of learning could not be properly implemented, and later, having to be crammed within the little time left for both teachers and students with the new school terms arriving.

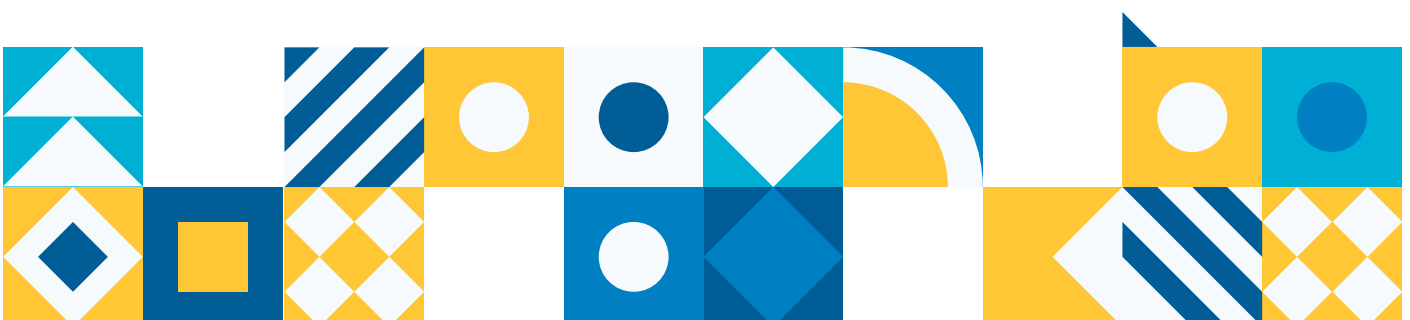
Why is this important, though?

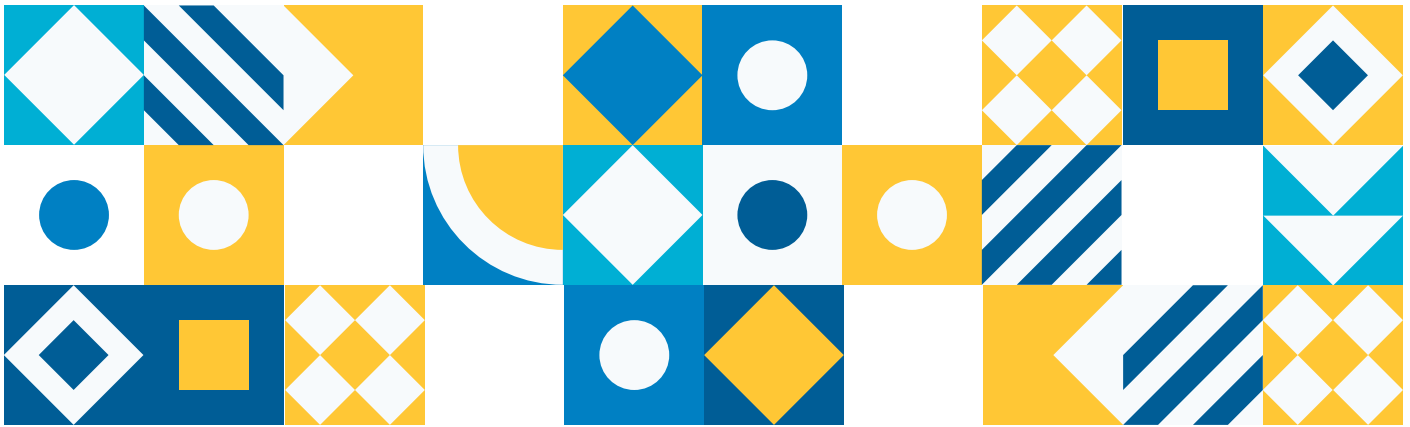
This lie in how the syllabus are developed, which often involved experts in the education sector to review and introduce necessary changes for the next cohort.

Do teachers get a say in the matter?

No. Syllabus deals with the overall framework of teaching each subject as well the general methodology for implementation which is teachers come into play.

They are the professionals who need to deep dive into what the syllabuses are all about, and then prepare for the actual practice of communicating the principles using methods appropriate for sharing them to their students. In other words, syllabuses are developed per se for teachers, not students.





With students staying home and quite a few taking to online classes organised by teachers who are also compensating with difficulties of conducting classes outside their skillset, parents too are now exposed to the actual methodology being used.

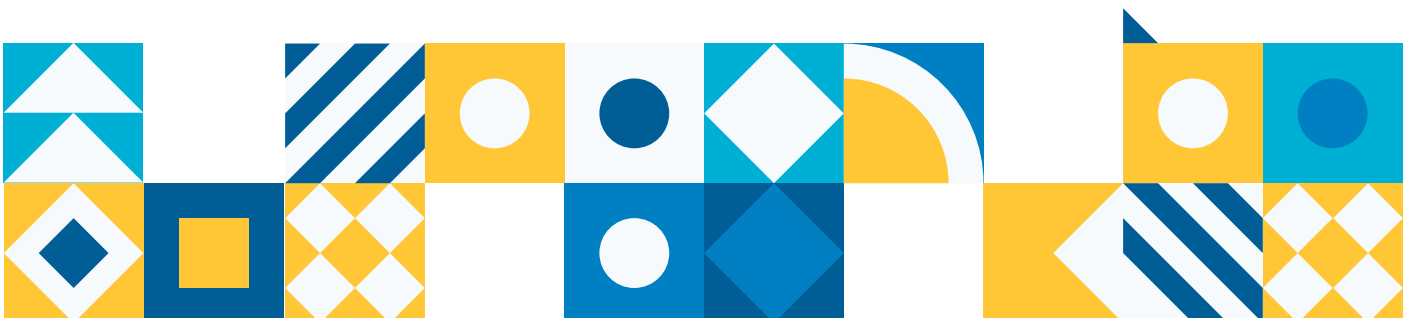
Alas, this exposure would be without the context of the overall syllabus's implementation and the marked difference in terms of methodologies applied in many cohorts throughout their decades of implementation.

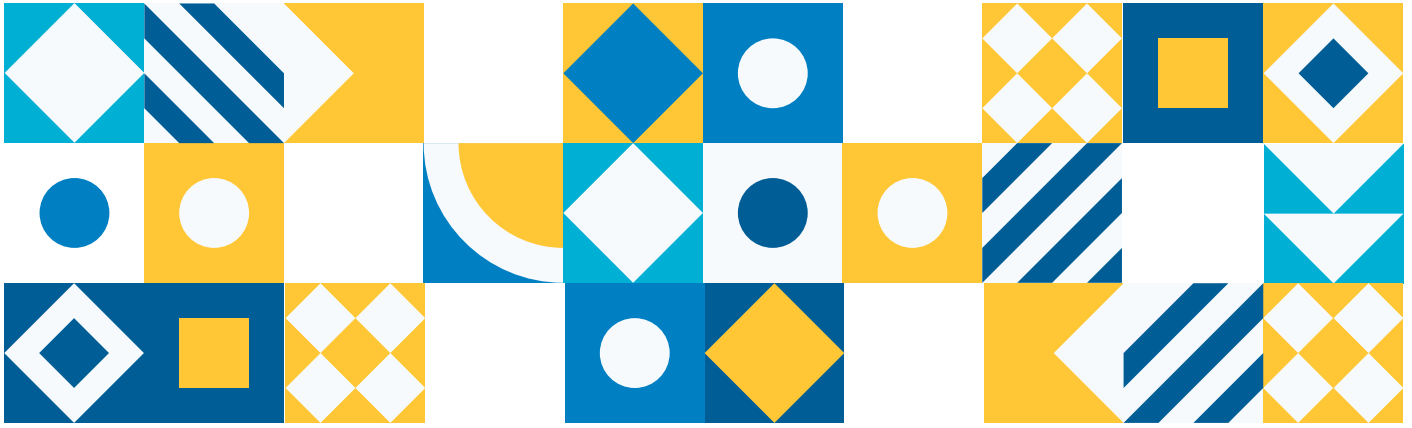
As the syllabus is spread out across six years for primary and five for secondary, with the methodology taking the progressive route in knowledge building and sharing implemented by teachers.

In a way, the spread in implementation also allows teachers to adapt, tweak and improve on the communication of the subject matters they are entrusted with.

The prolonged closure and later the intermittent opportunities for resumption of classroom sessions brought to the fore how advanced and compact – some might suggest crammed – the syllabus and how catching up is a race one would be hard-pressed to even compete.

Under normal circumstances with teachers pacing the subjects according to plan, there would be enough evidence to suggest what seemed difficult is not necessarily so whereby students who had gone through the many steps as set out would have a good level of understanding.





Schools are nonetheless fully aware of the drawback brought about by the pandemic closures, and many teachers had strived towards achieving the minimum, adequate level threshold allowing students to explore further on their own accord and move to the next level in their studying.

Understandably, this differs markedly given the contrast in available facilities and commitment of the teaching staff. The Government has acknowledged this unfortunate gap in unfamiliarity leading to contentions of the syllabus being more difficult than it should be.

What is important is to ensure any review do not shift the standards in our education to that way below acceptable global standards especially since the nation did not fare well in the Programme for International Student Assessment (Pisa) scoring.

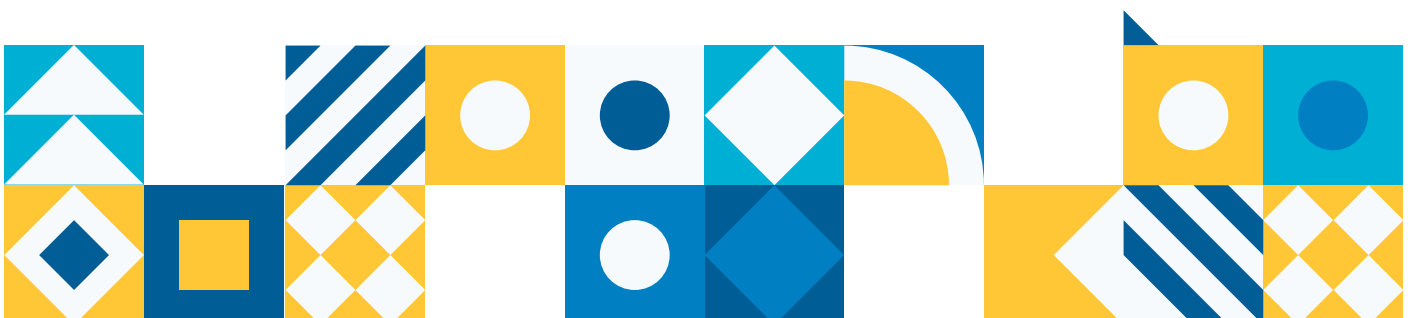
With the current cohort, which began in 2017, ending and the development of the syllabus for the next already well progressed, the feedback and experience from the enforced closures of schools would give some impetus to one capable of thriving in a hybrid system of both face-to-face and online teaching methodology.

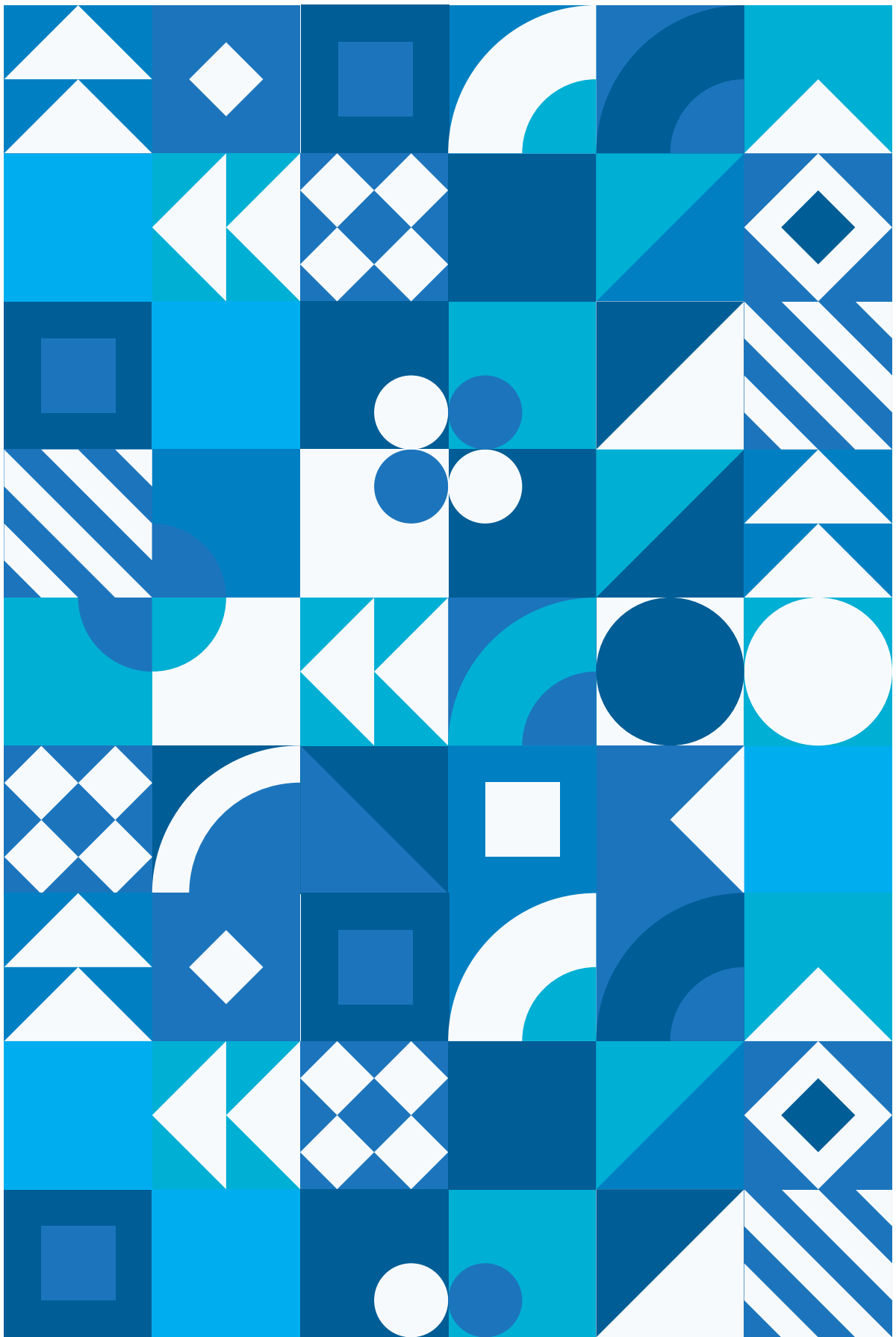


It should be noted that the new syllabus will only affect those entering Standard One next year who would be using it throughout their six years stint.

Should the country stick to a single tried and tested, effective syllabus instead of continuously changing it every time? Alas, an unwillingness to make changes would leave the country to lag even further behind other countries in terms of education.

A fine balance of progressiveness and stability is therefore an important aspect which the next cohort would do well to include as one of its main objectives to achieve.







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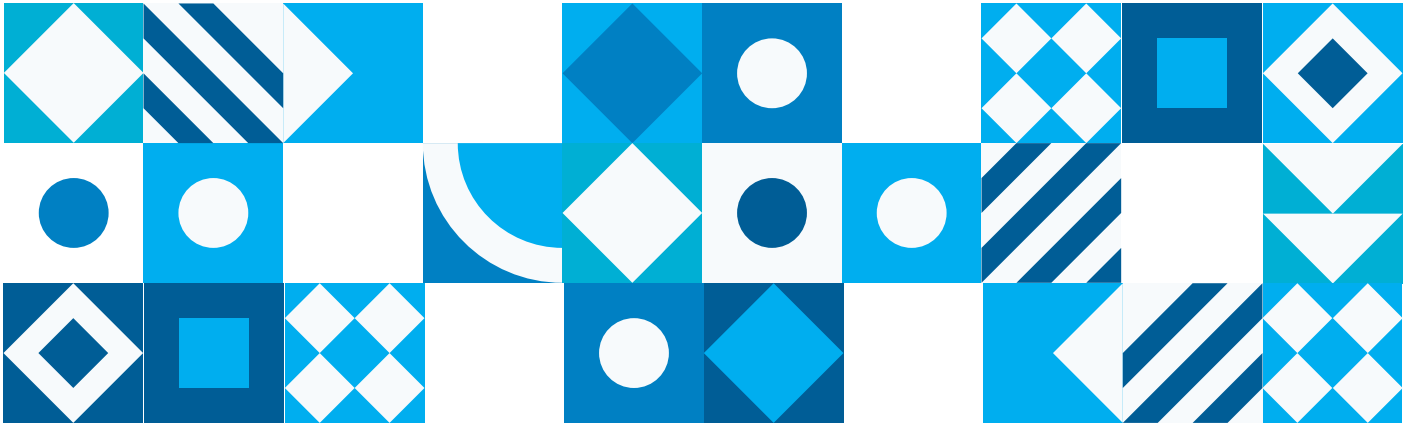
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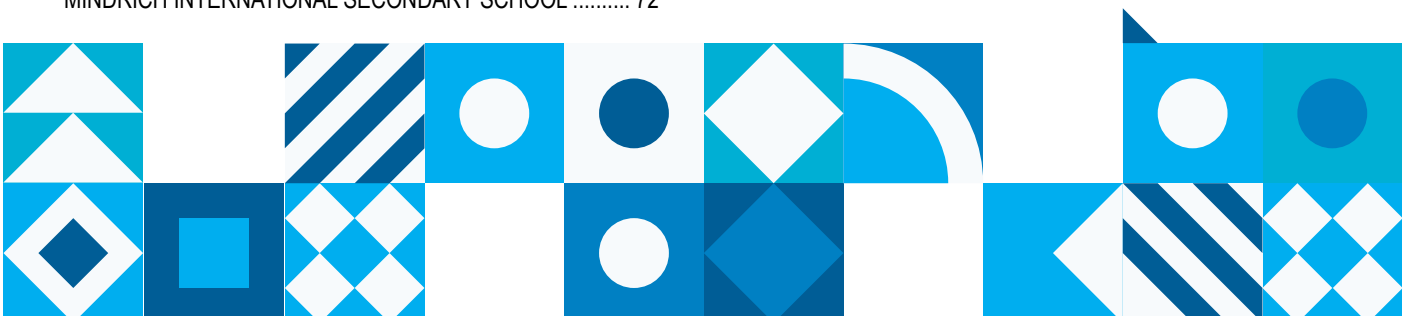
